Construction of Solid Waste Segregation Facility

The ECO Club and Science Club initiated the Project Segregate to strengthen the school's advocacy on solidwaste management being an eco-friendly school. A solidwaste segregation facility amounting to Php 12,565.00 was constructed through the proceeds of Paper Segregation Project and financial assistance given by the Praespero Minigrant of Ms. Wendi Pillars, a Teacher for Global Classrooms Fellow who was able to visit Boot National High School in June of 2016. The facility conditioned every student and teachers to put their trash in the proper cubicle which was labeled accordingly. This was collected twice a month. The trash produce is converted to cash. Likewise, each classroom and office has a container for white and colored paper to minimize garbage produce every day. Close monitoring is collaboratively done by class advisers and ECO Club to ensure that segregation is being followed. The classrooms which are cooperative is being recognized during flag raising ceremony.
